PROJECT OBJECTIVE

THIS PROJECT AIMS TO PROMOTE THE AWARENESS AND TRAINING OF HEALTH PROFESSIONALS FOR ISSUES OF IDENTITY AND DIVERSE SEXUAL ORIENTATIONS; ADDRESSING STIGMATISATION AND DISCRIMINATION OF LGBT PEOPLE IN SOCIETY AND HEALTH CARE SETTINGS; RAISING AWARENESS OF THE SPECIFICITIES OF ACCESS TO HEALTH CARE FOR LGBT PEOPLE; PRESENT THE NATIONAL AND INTERNATIONAL LEGAL FRAMEWORK FOR ISSUES IN THIS AREA AND THE CONCEPT OF HATE CRIME AND DOMESTIC VIOLENCE; ANALYSE EPIDEMIOLOGICAL DATA ON SEXUALLY TRANSMITTED INFECTIONS AND ASYMMETRIES IN ACCESS TO HEALTH SERVICES AFFECTING LGBT COMMUNITIES; IDENTIFY THE NETWORK OF SOCIAL SUPPORT RESOURCES FOR VICTIMS OF LGBT DOMESTIC VIOLENCE AND ITS INTERVENTION IN THE AREAS OF PREVENTION AND COMBATING DISCRIMINATION; IDENTIFY RESPONSES IN THE FIELD OF COMPETENCIES OF HEALTH SERVICES AND PROFESSIONALS.
