YOUR PROFILE

College Alpin Beau Soleil is looking to appoint a School Nurse, responsible for providing a clinically effective, high-quality service of nursing care and health promotion for students.

Under the responsibility of our Head Nurse, your key responsibilities include:

- Care of sick, injured and distressed students until further care is arranged as necessary
- Review, monitor and record the health status of all students on entry to school
- Organisation and delivery of vaccinations
- Liaise with all staff to identify children with particular developmental concerns, assess their health status and refer to specialist services where necessary
- Work with parents, carers, specialist health professionals and others to develop, implement and monitor in-school care plans for students with complex health needs and long-term conditions
- Implement and maintain arrangements for first-aid provision to comply with statutory requirements

- Maintain student health records on school and group core data base
- Contribute to the development of school emergency continuity plans, including response to outbreaks of communicable diseases
- Coordinate the transportation of students to outpatient appointments
- Conduct substance abuse screening tests in line with school policy and procedures
- Provide out-of-hours 'on call' advice and in extremely rare circumstances provide 24 hours cover in the medical centre
- Play an active role in health promotion through the planning, delivery and support of the school welfare programme
- Maintain good communication with boarding staff to ensure that students who are unwell receive appropriate and timely care and medication
- Ensure that the medical centre, medical facilities, defibrillator, and first aid kits throughout the school are maintained to meet the school's requirements
